Guidelines for MISSOURI SHEEP SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Eligible applicants are college students or high school seniors who are residents of Missouri and attending a college or university (in-state or out-of-state) of their choice or out-of-state students attending a Missouri college or university.
- 2. Applicants must be or have been a 4-H or FFA member with a sheep project, or have been involved with the sheep industry for **at least three years**. A letter of recommendation from the project leader or chapter advisor should be included with the application.
- 3. The Missouri Sheep Producers will award four (4) \$500 scholarships.
- 4. Applicants may only receive the Missouri Sheep Producers Scholarship one time.
- 5. Applicants who are not awarded a scholarship are encouraged to reapply.
- 6. Undergraduate and graduate level students are eligible to apply.
- The Scholarship Committee will judge the applications. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail and their checks will be presented at the Missouri State Fair.
- 8. Complete applications must be postmarked by the deadline or they will not be reviewed.
